

LIKELY CHANGE TO PERMIT REQUIREMENTS IN NSW

Big news...

Following a report released by the NSW Office of Liquor and Gaming, promoters are now one step closer to being able to conduct trade promotions with prize pools under \$10k in NSW with NO permit.

The report also recommended removing the permit requirement for certain community gaming activities with prizes valued less than \$30k, such as housie, raffles and art unions.

Legal requirements will remain in respect of how promotions must be conducted and certain details to be included in Terms and Conditions.

Compliance audits by regulators, and a new civil penalty regime, will provide the regulator with robust enforcement tools. Enforcement action will become more likely in relation to "minor" breaches of the law.
