
# Pro Bono and Corporate Responsibility at Gadens

We continued to fund a secondee at Women's Legal Service Victoria, and have partnered with Women's Legal Service Queensland for over 10 years



A team of 12 support staff volunteered around **68 hours** (or \$13,600 worth) of administrative support to the Women's Legal Service Victoria



A team travelled to **Nauru** for a Pro Bono matter. Over the year we carried out 606.8 hours of Pro Bono work assisting asylum seekers and refugees

We celebrated:

- The launch of a new formalised partnership with Peninsula **Community Legal Centre**
- Our continuing partnership with Fitzroy Community Legal
- Three years of partnership with Moonee Valley Legal Service:
  - Of the 48 advices given, 28 were delivered through the Gadens Clinic
  - Of the 22 matters opened in 2019, 7 were opened after attending the Gadens clinic, 5 have been closed and
- Our support for the creation of Charitable Foundations (Small Steps for Hannah), in an effort to help stop domestic violence
- Our ongoing partnership with the 'Lord Mayors Charitable Trust' in Brisbane
